The scope of each competition – **HUNTING RIFLE SHOOTING according to IHRSA rules** 30 shots (usually divided into 6 × 5 shots or 1 × 10 + 4 × 5 shots) at different targets and gongs from different positions and using different supports.

From shooters that participate in at least three of the four competitions will be drawn one shooter, who will receive a Shooting set (ammunition SB MATCH, rifle CZ, rifle scope MEOPTA) and a possibility to hunt red stag or fallow deer in the game preserve of Sellier & Bellot a.s.

## THIS YEAR'S SELLIER & BELLOT MATCH SERIES ALLOWS REGISTRATION ONLY IN THE OPEN CATEGORY

According to the placement in the 2018 series and criteria specified by the CZHRSA executive committee, shooters of the OPEN category will compete in three performance classes:

**Gold:** Forró Miroslav, Hlušíčka Martin, Staněk Tomáš, Šlechta Martin, Mahel Jindřich.

**Silver:** Valchář Petr, Soukup Vlastislav, Kelner Ondřej, Skudla Martin, Svoboda Zdeněk, Čech Antonín, Borák Ondřej, Kirchner Milan, Šíma Jaroslav, Šustek Michal, Laštůvka Petr, Tomášek Jaroslav, Pšenčík Zdeněk, Kydlíček Pavel.

**Bronze:** all other registered shooters

New shooters at their first competition will be assessed in the Bronze class and will be moved only if they achieve Gold class performance. From the next competition, they will be assessed throughout the series in the Silver category.

According to the overall results (without class differences), the absolute ranking of each individual competition will be determined and the best shooters will be awarded.

If registering for the competition in advance and paying the start fee, the shooter can also order **60 Sellier & Bellot Match cartridges** in calibre, which the shooter will use for the competition at a discounted price (**calibres 222 Rem and 223 Rem – 15 CZK/cartridge, other calibres 20 CZK/cartridge**). These shooters will also have a 100 CZK discount on the start fee, compared to shooters that register and pay the fee at the shooting range on the day of the competition.

**Registering for only one of the two shooting days is not possible.**

#### Technical provisions of the OPEN category:

- shooting fixed targets with a rifle from calibre 22 Hornet (using semi-automatic guns is forbidden)
- the shooter must shoot throughout the competition with one gun
- the rifle weight is unlimited
- bipods are forbidden
- a strap fastened by one end to the fore-end and the other to the stock is allowed
- gloves are allowed
- you can use all types of hunting ammunition, including full metal jacket (special military ammunition and steel-core ammunition is forbidden)
- one day consists of a total of 30 shots, usually divided into 6 stages of 5 shots (the distribution can be different)
- the shooting distance is 50 to 400 metres (**the distance will be known**)
- there will be different time limits for shooting each item, usually 90 seconds (120 seconds maximum). The time limit also includes the time of taking position on the shooting line.
- rifle scope's magnification is not restricted
- other provisions are governed by the IHRSA international rules, objection – 500 CZK deposit
- the result of each shooter will be expressed as a percentage of the result of the competition winner, whose result will be 100 %. The percentages achieved from individual competitions will be included in the final assessment.

#### Assessment:

- within 30 minutes of the end of shooting
- all items are assessed together

The first three shooters in the absolute order will receive cups and prizes. According to the organizer's options, other top shooters will receive small prizes. In the OPEN category, cups will be awarded to the first three shooters in performance classes (gold, silver and bronze).
